

### What are the Signs of Speech Delay By Age?



- 1. Lack of Babbling
- 2. No Gesturing
- 12 months
- 3. Limited Sound Making or Response to them

18 months



2. No Attempt to Imitate

3. Lack of understanding simple commands



- 1. Fewer than 50 vocabulary 2.
- 2. No Two-Word Phrases
  - 3. Difficulty Following Simple Instructions

24 months



3 years

- 1. Difficulty with Pronouns and Plurals
  - 2. Limited Vocabulary and Unclear Speech
  - 3. Social Communication Issues
- 1. Not Speaking in Full Sentences
  - 2. Speech is Hard to Understand
- 4-5 years
- 3. Limited Use of Past Tense or Future Tense
